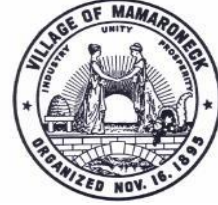

The development at 532 West Boston Post Road, at the intersection with Delancey Avenue, included several off-site improvements such as new sidewalks and trees. The developer entered an agreement with Consolidated Edison in which the developer paid to remove a utility pole directly in front of the property and re-route the infrastructure around the block. In doing so, a pole mounted typical street was removed along with the pole. The developer was asked to mitigate this by installing three ornamental street lights, matching the style the Village owns along Mamaroneck Avenue and Boston Post Road, at no cost to the Village but has upgraded the luminaire, per my requirement, to LED. The developer has completed installation of these street lights and now requests to dedicate this to the Village which will enable the Village to request Consolidated Edison to energize these fixtures. The developer provided a documents indicating the location of the lights, attached for your reference.

I believe these lights added to the aesthetic value of the Village along a main corridor in the Village and across near to one of the Village's greatest assets, Harbor Island Park.
