- 3. High dead branch removal, based on hourly rates, based on itemized Trees on a tree-by-tree basis.
- 4. Providing a total volume (in cubic yards), tonnage and recycling/re-use plan for all materials removed from the Village of Mamaroneck WITH EACH INVOICE FOR PAYMENT (such report is necessary for the compilation of the Village's Annual Recycling Report).
- Bidder is responsible for maintenance and protection of traffic, at no additional cost to the Village.
