The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC or Department) is in receipt of the Village of Mamaroneck's SEQR Lead Agency Coordination for the water line replacement for 700-702 Taylors Lane. The Department issued a permit (which was included with Lead Agency coordination materials) pursuant to Articles 15 & 25 of the ECL, and a CWA Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this project on March 12, 2019. As part of our processing of the application which led to this permit, the Department completed SEQR through an uncoordinated review of this Unlisted action via a Negative Declaration, and made our final decision on the action through means of the permit. Therefore, DEC currently has no discretionary decision to make on this action and would not be an involved agency under SEQR for this coordinated review.
