WHEREAS, in performing its due diligence responsibilities, Village staff contacted vendors to determine if there was any opportunity to sell these items either directly or at auction, and

WHEREAS, due to the furniture systems having been discontinued in 2005, there is no secondary market for these items, and due to security concerns associated with parking meters, it is irresponsible to place these items up for auction; and

WHEREAS, Village staff recommends that the Village Manager be authorized to dispose of these items in a responsible manner,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees declares the following equipment as surplus Village property and authorizes the Village Manager to dispose of said items in a manner he deems most appropriate:
