WINTER STORM ALERTS

Storm alerts are issued to contacts 24-48 hours prior to the anticipated arrival of any precipitation containing any combinations of snow, sleet or freezing rain. Alerts are transmitted as designated by the client (email, fax and/or web page) and provide details on anticipated start, end, intensity, accumulation confidence and any critical hazards that may affect your winter operations. Written updates are at the discretion of the meteorologist on duty but often provide 2-3 updates per day through the duration of the event.

WARM SEASON STORM ALERTS

Storm alerts are issued to contacts up to 12 hours prior to the anticipated arrival of any severe storms or tropical systems containing damaging winds, hail, tornado potential and/or flooding rains. Alerts are transmitted as designated by the client (email, fax and/or web page) and provide details on anticipated start, end, intensity, accumulation confidence and any critical hazards that may impact your warm season operations. Written updates are at the discretion of the meteorologist on duty.

24/7 TELEPHONE CONSULTATION

Unlimited telephone consultation with a meteorologist is always available at WeatherWorks for real-time verbal updates and so that we may address your weather related concerns throughout the year. The service may be accessed by designated company personnel only and is limited to 1 primary contact and a backup unless otherwise specified in the contract.

CALL-TO-ACTION HEADS UP NOTIFICATION

Rely on our staff of 30 professional meteorologists to monitor your sites 24/7 and provide zero tolerance notification to designated contacts via mobile app, text message or email 1-2 hours prior to the onset of any winter precipitation which may result in a slippery condition and up to 1 hour in advance of warm season severe weather (flooding, damaging winds, tornado, etc). You must download the WeatherWorks mobile app from the Google Play or Apple Store and link your device to your WeatherWorks settings to receive the notification for your region(s).

CERTIFIED SNOWFALL TOTALS

Access to the Nation's leading and industry preferred post storm snow and ice verification service. All post storm reports are quality controlled, prepared, certified for accuracy and published online at www.CertifiedSnowfallTotals.com within 48 hours after the conclusion of each winter event. Reports include a narrative description of the storm event with pertinent details on timing, temperature, wind, etc and zip code resolution totals to the nearest 0.1 inch.

DAILY FORECASTS

5 Day forecasts are issued year-round (12 months), Monday through Friday and contain a narrative synopsis of the expected weather pattern and a detailed breakdown of each day's expected weather. Forecast components include anticipated sky cover, precipitation threats, high / low temperature, wind, potential for re-freeze or freeze up conditions (during winter) and potential for severe weather (warm season).

LONG RANGE FORECASTS

Components of the service include a blog discussion from our long range meteorologist, an in-depth long range pattern discussion and a predictive outlook for 3 periods extending out to 2 months. Forecasts are updated bi-weekly online (approximately 2 times per month).

WEATHER WEB PAGE

Stay on top of the latest weather conditions for your forecast area with access to current conditions, river levels, sunrise / sunset times, drought monitoring and an interactive map displaying radar, satellite and your exact forecast regions. Tropical outlook and tidal information present if applicable.

WEATHERWORKS MOBILE APP

Search for "WeatherWorks" and download our FREE app from the Google Play (Android) or Apple Store to maximize the value of your WeatherWorks Storm Alert service. Receive forecasts / storm alerts, heads up notification and report snowfall all within our mobile app for Android and Apple smart phone devices. Once you have the app loaded on your phone you should follow the instructions to link your device to your WeatherWorks settings. Your phone number must be linked to your online account in order to receive forecasts and "heads up" notification for your region(s) on the mobile app. Login to weatherworksinc.com and

proceed to Heads Up Settings and change your prior method over to "APP" to start receiving your "Heads Up" Notifications within the WeatherWorks Mobile App. More new and exciting features will be added to the app over the coming year.
