# PROPOSED LOCAL LAW K – 2021

# A Proposed Local Law to amend Chapter 260, Parks, as it relates to prohibiting the smoking of tobacco or cannabis products in Village parks

# BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mamaroneck as follows:

## Section 1.

Section 260-3(S) of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is hereby amended as follows:

(S) Except in areas which may be specifically designated by the Village Manager and marked as "Smoking Areas," sSmoke or burn tobacco, or a tobacco substitute, or cannabis or concentrated cannabis as defined in Cannabis Law §3; or carry burning tobacco, or a tobacco substitute, or cannabis or concentrated cannabis as defined in Cannabis Law §3 in the form of a cigarette, cigar, pipe or any other smoke-producing product or device;, including pipes, or use electronic cigarettes, vapes, or other similar products that rely on vaporization or aerosolization; or dispose of tobacco or cannabis products, lit or unlit, including cigarette butts, or cigar butts, electronic cigarettes, vapes, or other similar products, except in containers designated for that purpose.

### Section 2.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this local law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, the portion of the law declared to be invalid will be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and the declaration will not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which will continue in full force and effect.

### Section 3.

This law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Municipal Home Rule Law \$10(1)(e)(3) and will supersede the provisions of the Village Law to the extent that they are inconsistent with this local law.

### Section 4.

This local law will take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law § 27.
