Westchester County Department of Human Resources requests your assistance in updating our records. Please e-scan a copy of your local law and/or municipal code that identifies your current residency requirements for individuals appointed to positions that are subject to New York State Public Officers Law. In addition, please provide a copy of the confirmation letter issued by NYS Department of State Records and Law Bureau confirming filing of the local law. If your municipality has not passed a local law with respect to residency requirements for Public Officers, please confirm that all Public Officers appointed in your municipality must be residents of your respective municipality.

Receipt of this information is crucial as Westchester County Department of Human Resources intends to ensure appointments to Public Officer positions are made in compliance with residency requirements as outlined in applicable laws.

It is important to note: failure to provide this documentation may result in the Westchester County Department of Human Resources not certifying you Civil Service eligible lists at your request to fill positions which are subject to New York State Public Officers Law.
