SAPOA revisited the maintenance situation at our last board meeting. We realize that the design and maintenance are complex, and decided that, with Village approval, we would like to assume full responsibility for the work, both the hiring and the supervision.

The circles are Village property. May we have your approval?

Dear Jerry and Jeff,

I am writing on behalf of the Shore Acres Property Owners Association.

At Saturday's board meeting, we discussed Jeff's recent correspondence with Allison Stabile about maintenance for the three circles along the center of The Parkway. We recognize that the landscaping, an intricate layering of native plants, is very high maintenance and easily overgrows its design. Some of our Shore Acres neighbors donate their own time weeding and cutting back, but it is a huge job.

We are aware of the many parks and landscaping obligations of the VOM Parks Department. Jeff recently shared his plan to have these areas maintained by an outside contractor, but we are concerned that the amount of time needed is more than the Village can allot to three circles.

SAPOA would like to propose a public/private partnership for maintaining the circles. Members would continue volunteering their time or pay a private gardener to do the work. SAPOA is willing to reimburse out-of pocket payments for a private gardener, but we would be grateful if the Village would share some portion of the cost. SAPOA would provide copies of the reimbursements and of the original invoices.

The circles were originally landscaped in partnership with the Village. They are true centerpieces and a point of pride for Shore Acres. The neighborhood looks run down when they are overgrown with weeds, rather as it would if the streets were strewn with litter. With responsibility for only this small portion of the Village park system, SAPOA could keep the circles maintained in the manner of the original design.
