SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION OF SEAN CHRISTIE FOR A VARIANCE

Applicant seeks a special permit and variance to open a bubble tea shop at 317 Mamaroneck Ave. The premises had formerly been a salon and is within 200' of Garden Catering a food service establishment as defined in 342-45 of the village code.

Applicant intends to serve bubble tea and potentially prepared food products for take-out and eatin, which classifies it as a food establishment under 342-45.

Applicant requires a variance.

- The granting of the variance will not result in an undesirable change in the character of the neighborhood or be a detriment to nearby properties. The product is unique and is different from the fare offered at Garden Catering or anywhere else in the Village.
- There is no other way the applicant can open the business at this location without a variance.
- The variance is not substantial
- The proposed variance will not have an adverse effect on the physical or environmental conditions in the neighborhood. In fact, it will be an asset to the area.
- The difficulty was self-created to the extent applicant entered into a lease prior to obtaining a variance.

It is my responsibility as the Applicant to complete this Application completely and carefully, and to provide sixteen (16) copies of this Application, together with all necessary papers, plans, surveys, documents or other required information.

Failure to submit the required documents and information will delay my Application or result in its denial, since the ZBA cannot review or grant relief to incomplete Applications.
